- 4. Floridian Group State Legislative Session Update (Mike Cantens) via Zoom. Mike Cantens joined us remotely and provided an update on current legislative efforts. He specifically mentioned EFI being absolved, moving some of the functions over to DEO for a cost savings. The Live Local Act for affordable housing was signed at the end of March. This is a large incentive for housing challenges. Space Florida's predicted economic impact for the next decade is profound and they will be receiving record funding. The state cybersecurity SOC is moving as well. Efforts with Senator Broxson and Janice Gilley are happening. There are contingencies for predicted paths forward. We are looking for \$1.5-\$2M for that effort.

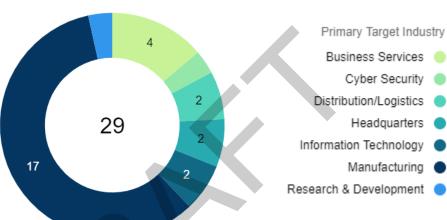

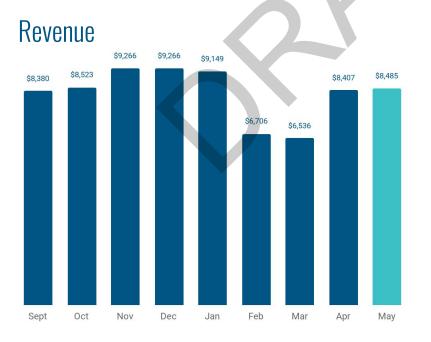

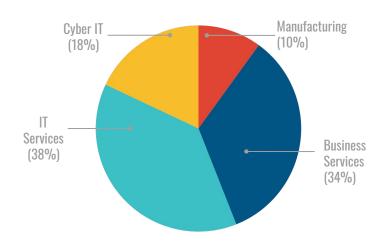
